We have special condolences to the families and friends of Dr. Angel De Pedro who passed away on December 2, 2009.

Howard Gary who was former City Manager of Miami from 1981 to 1984, passed away on February 15, 2009. He broke the ground as the first Black City Manager.

Miami Fire Department reunion dates are September 17-19, 2009, In Otto, North Carolina.

Under AFSCME's group tax-exemption ruling, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has excepted the International Union and all AFSCME affiliates from having to pay Federal Income tax on dues income, "exempt function income" and other receipts defined by the IRS as "excluded income.

Health Care: Tony Fransetta, President of Florida Alliance for Retired Americans, worked with Representative Joseph Abruzzo in introducing HR 10161, urging Congress to pass legislation that establishes a national universal health care program with a comprehensive range of benefits.

The Miami Dade Commission, the City of Miami Commission and the Miami Marlins have approved the funds for the building of the new stadium to be completed in 2012, on the site of the old Orange Bowl. Four Hundred Eighty Million coming from tourist tax, the Marlins share is 120 millions and the county will repay 35 millions for the 3,700 seats' stadium with a retractable roof.

The market value of the FIPO Trust assets had been \$1,268,869,871. On September 30, 2008 the market value was \$1,020,161,862.

The COLA reserve has been approximately \$65,116,055, they had to transfer out \$18,940,038, leaving \$46,176,017 as a balance in the COLA reserve. As you can see the bad market can quickly have a devastating impact on our main COLA fund and the COLA reserve.
